Enclosed you will find the FREE Discount Prescription Drug cards you requested. We have also enclosed additional cards that you can give to family members, friends or anyone who can use them. Below are some of the most frequently asked questions:

What is this program and how can it help me? The FreeRxPlus® Prescription Savings Program is a **FREE** program that benefits the uninsured, underinsured, Medicare Part D participants, those with High Deductible Health Plans, and those with high co-pays. Simply present this card to a participating pharmacy when you drop off a prescription and receive a discount on your medication. This card can also be used on your pet's medication; simply ask the veterinarian to prescribe the human equivalent of the medication to receive savings.

How much of a discount will I receive? All FDA approved medications are included. Discounts vary depending on the medication and the pharmacy. Discounts typically range from 15% to 75% with the largest savings coming from generic medications. The program provides savings as high as 90% and ensures the customer receives the lowest price at the pharmacy!

How much does it cost to participate? The FreeRxPlus® Prescription Savings Program is free.

When does the card expire? The card has no expiration date and can be used every time you need a prescription medication filled. You can even share the same card with friends and family.

What if the pharmacy offers me their discount card? Always ask the pharmacy technician to check the medication price with both cards to ensure you receive the lowest price. Eight out of ten times, the FreeRxPlus price is lowest.

Can I use the discount card if I have insurance? Our card benefits people without insurance or prescription drug coverage the most. Some insurance plans have high co-pays or sometimes the co-pay costs more

than the medication would with our card so it's hard to say. The best way to find out is to visit FreeRxPlus.com and click on the Search Prices link at the top. You'll be able to enter the medications and your zip code to see the price you would pay at the pharmacy. If our price is lower than what the cost is using the insurance card, then our discount card should be used instead of your insurance card.

Can I use the discount card if I have an insurance deductible? In most cases you should be able to use our discount card. However, not all deductible insurance plans work the same so we recommend contacting your prescription drug coverage provider for verification.

Where can I use the card? With over 54,000 participating pharmacies, it is simple to find a pharmacy that will accept our card. Most major chains and independent pharmacies throughout the United States and Puerto Rico are included in this program. A few of our participating pharmacies are listed on the left.
